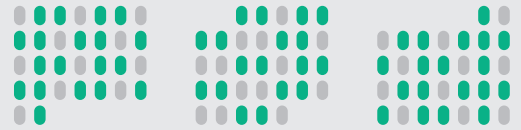

Use mats and sweep



Frequency

As needed to keep your entrance free of debris.

Why?

Stop soil in its tracks. Remove soil at entryways to prevent dirt from entering the facility. This will help maintain floors throughout the building.

What to do

Sweep sidewalks and entry ways, vacuum mats daily.

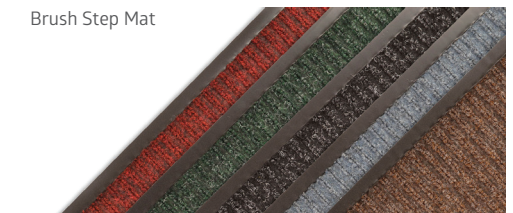

Hard surface floor—dust and clean



Frequency

Dust and clean every day.

Why?

To minimize damage to flooring including carpeted areas. Dust mop then scrub or wet mop with a neutral cleanser or disinfectant to prevent excess dirt from accumulating on pads and equipment so it's not scrubbed into the floor finish.

What to do

1. Put on appropriate PPE
2. Place wet floor sign
3. Dust mop floor
4. Wet mop floor or auto scrub

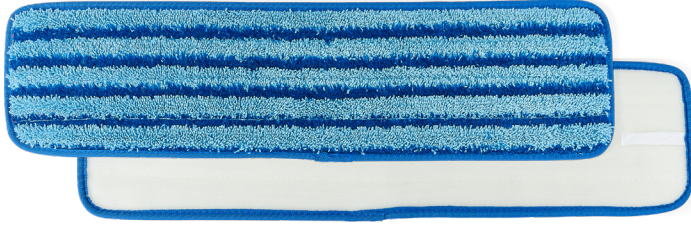

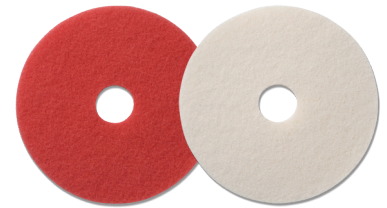

Frequency

Burnish 3x per week

Finished floors

Burnish 3x per week

What to do

1. Put on appropriate PPE
2. Place wet floor sign
3. Dust mop floor
4. Wet mop or auto scrub
5. Mop on burnishing solution
6. While floor is damp, burnish with a high speed machine (1500+ RPM), turning or replacing pad as required
7. Dust mop

PRO TIP

Using Medline Floor Rejuvenator (EVSCHM580) can reduce the frequency of burnishing, saving you on floor care labor costs.

PRO TIP

What is burnishing? The process of smoothing away any scratches that could capture dirt. Burnishing works by heating up the floor finish with high-speed machine and mildly resurfacing before smoothing the top layer of finish.

Top scrub and recoat



Frequency

Weekly or bi-weekly maintenance

Finished floors

Scrub and recoat 3-4 times per month

Why?

Remove upper layers of old, discolored, or damaged floor finish and apply new fresh coats.

What to do

Top scrub with autoscrubber

1. Assemble equipment and supplies
2. Put on appropriate PPE
3. Place wet floor sign
4. Dust mop floor
5. Autoscrub or double scrub for heavy soils
6. Rinse floor with clean water

Top scrub with side-by-side or rotary

1. Assemble equipment and supplies
2. Put on appropriate PPE
3. Place wet floor sign
4. Dust mop floor
5. Liberally apply general purpose
6. Scrub floor with machine, making several passes to remove soil
7. Wet vac the area
8. Rinse floor with clean mop and clean, cold water

Recoat finished floors

1. Assemble equipment and supplies
2. Put on appropriate PPE
3. Place wet floor sign
4. Dust mop floor
5. Apply finish with mop. Allow appropriate dry time between coats, following product directions on packaging.

Carpeted floors



Frequency

Weekly or bi-weekly maintenance

Why?

A consistent routine of spotting, bonneting, and extracting is essential to maintaining the appearance, smell, and longevity of carpeted areas.

What to do

Carpet spotting (as needed)

1. Vacuum area thoroughly
2. Apply carpet spotter chemical directly onto the stain and let it sit for 1–3 minutes, adjusting the time as necessary
3. Gently blot or brush, working outer portion to inner portion of spot

Carpet Bonneting (quarterly)

1. Vacuum area throughly
2. Using a pump or trigger sprayer, apply the Carpet Pre-Treat Solution according to the product directions, and allow it to soak for 5 minutes.
3. Bonnet using pad and slow-speed floor scrubber, working from back of the room towards the front, flipping or changing out pad as needed

Carpet Extraction (biannual)

1. Vacuum thoroughly
2. Apply Pre-Treat Solution following product directions and allow to soak for five minutes
3. Fill carpet extractor with Carpet Extraction Rinse following product directions, and extract based on machine instructions

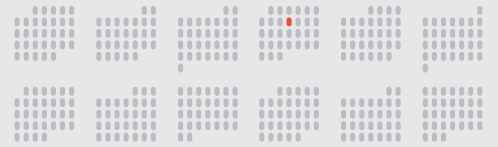

Strip and refinish.



Frequency

Strip and refinish annually

Why?

To make your floors shine. Remove the old finish and apply new layers.

What to do

Strip

1. Assemble equipment and supplies
2. Put on appropriate PPE
3. Place wet floor sign
4. Dust mop floor
5. Liberally apply stripper solution.
6. Machine Scrub Floor making several passes to remove finish. Keeping floor wet as needed.
7. Wet vac area
8. Rinse floor with clean mop and clean, cold water.

Re-coat finished floors

1. Assemble equipment and supplies
2. Put on appropriate PPE
3. Place wet floor sign
4. Dust mop floor
5. Apply finish with mop (allow appropriate dry time between coats, following product directions on packaging).

PRO TIP

When stripping, follow the manufacturer's instructions to **safely remove the existing finish.**

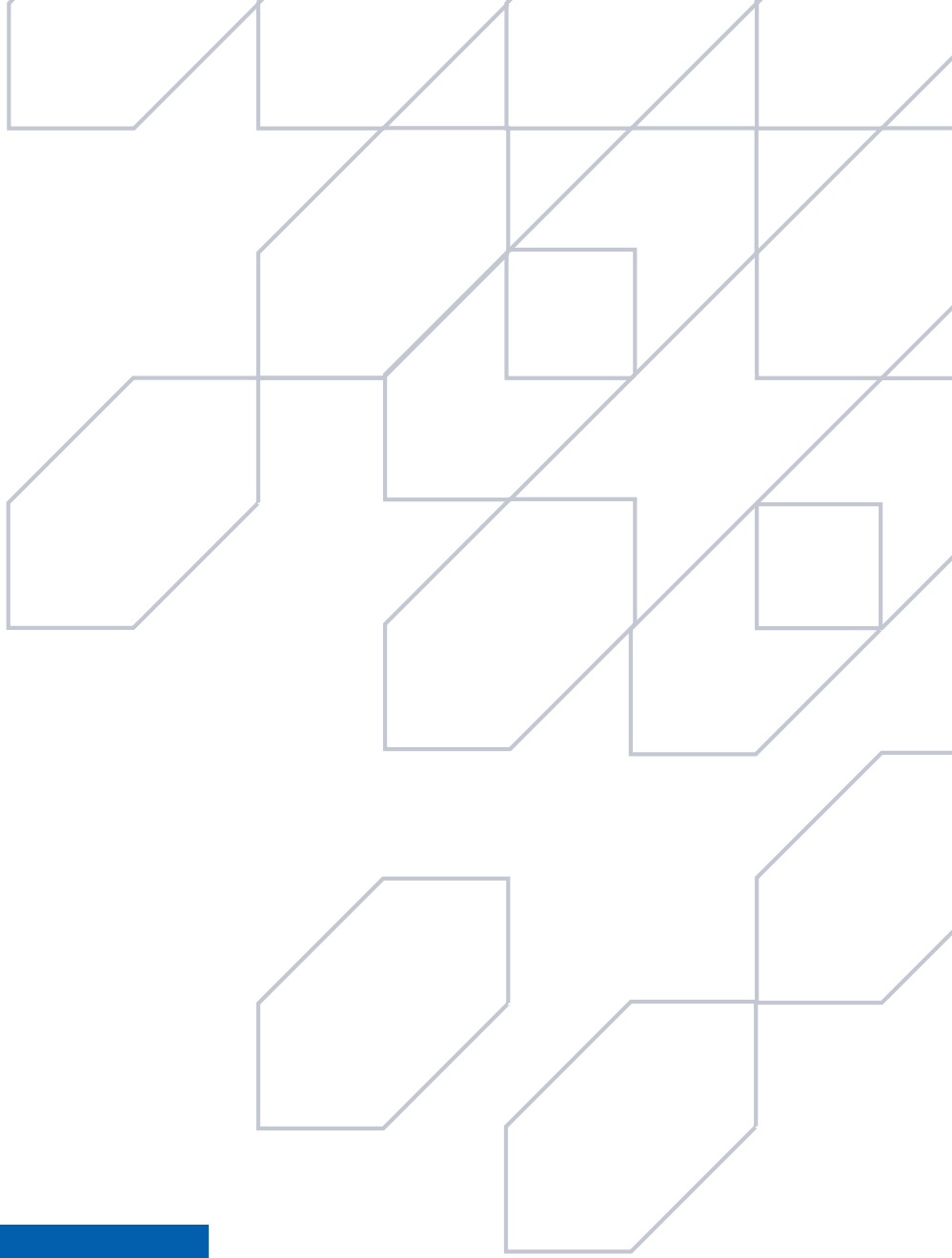
