- Can be reapplied

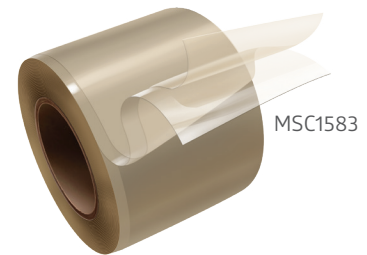
