

Silicone Adhesive Foam Dressings

McKesson silicone adhesive foam dressings are absorbent and atraumatic dressings that absorb exudate, maintain a moist wound-healing environment, and act as a barrier to liquids and microorganisms from the wound. The wound contact surface of the silicone adhesive foam dressing is coated with a layer of soft silicone that does not adhere to the wound surface or cause trauma to delicate new tissue upon removal. This soft silicone layer is also slightly tacky, which facilitates application and retention of the dressing to intact skin, but does not cause epidermal stripping or pain on removal.

Indications: McKesson silicone adhesive foam dressings are indicated for the management of exuding wounds, such as leg and foot ulcers, pressure ulcers, traumatic and surgical wounds, as well as superficial and partial-thickness burns. The dressing absorbs exudate and maintains a moist wound-healing environment while minimizing the risk of maceration. It may be applied and changed by clinicians or patients.

Contraindications: Discontinue use if the patient is allergic to any components of the dressing.

Change Frequency: The interval between dressing changes will depend entirely upon the state of the wound and the nature of the secondary dressing. Dressing applied to heavily exuding or sloughy wounds may need to be replaced daily initially; however, as healing progresses and the amount of exudate decreases, the interval between changes can be extended to up to 7 days or as directed by healthcare professional.

Features and Benefits

- Perforated silicone gel adhesive provides gentle but firm adhesion
- Highly conformable and remains intact on skin
- Soft silicone minimizes pain to patients and trauma to wounds upon removal
- Affixes securely to dry, intact skin; seals the wound margins to help prevent exudate from leaking on surrounding tissue, minimizing risk of maceration
- Breathable, moisture and bacteria resistant outer film layer
- Absorbent inner hydrocellular foam pad maintains a moist wound environment to help promote healing
- Dressing may be lifted and repositioned without losing its adherent properties
- Wear time up to 7 days or as directed by a healthcare professional
- Not made with natural rubber latex

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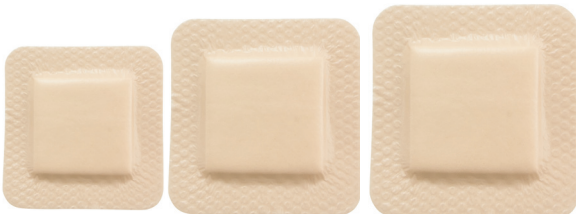
