



SDS, Section 13, Disposal Considerations

The following is an explanation and clarification of SDS, Section 13, Disposal Considerations:

SEC. 13. DISPOSAL CONSIDERATIONS

Waste Disposal: Can be used after re-conditioning. Recover by distillation or remove to a permitted waste disposal facility. Comply with applicable Federal, State/Provincial and Local Regulations.

Environmental Hazards: Empty pressure vessels should be returned to the supplier.

This above section (Waste Disposal and Environmental Hazards) refers to large, industrial sized, aerosol “vessels”. These “vessels” contain significant amounts of refrigerant used in manufacturing processes to fill large numbers of individual canisters – generally thousands during a single filling process. These large, industrial sized vessels can be reused, discarded, or returned to the original aerosol supplier in accordance with applicable government regulations.

Single, empty, canisters produced and branded by Nuance Medical as CryoDose V and CryoTherapy (McKesson Brand) are standard, steel metal, canisters. These canisters may be discarded as normal trash or as recycling according to local, state, or each facility’s recommendations. No “red bag” disposal or recycling is required.
